Christmas Production DVD

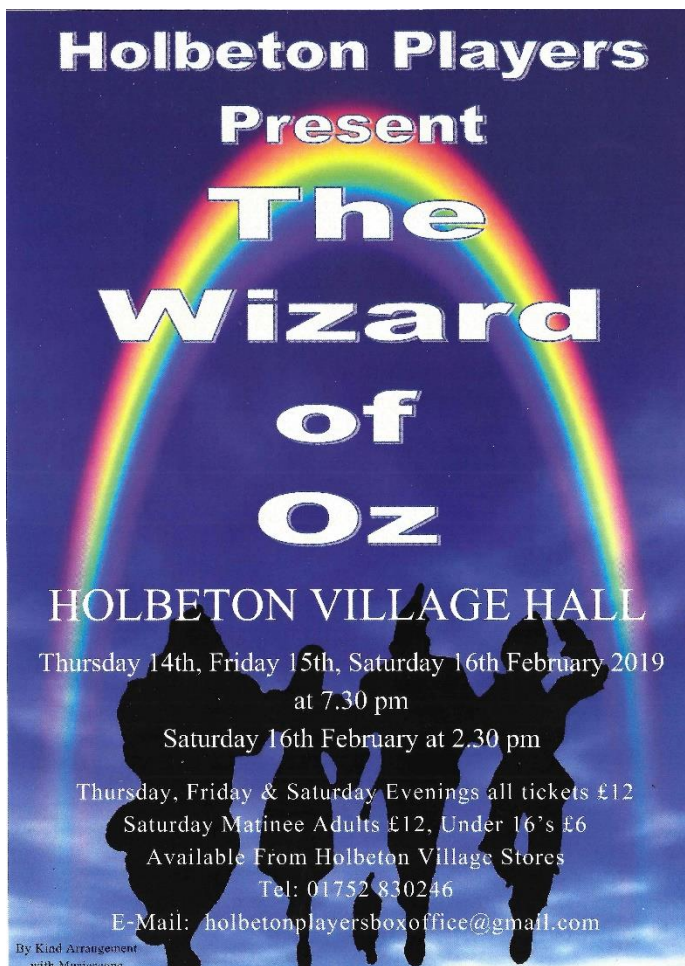
We know it's January, but we do still have a few copies left. They are £5 each from the School Office.
