

## Sports Premium Funding 2016-2017

Number of pupils on roll: 38

Sports Funding Total: £ 8,300

Funding is targeted towards:

1. Delivery of high quality PE provision with -Premier Education Group (<https://www.premier-education.com>) . This included running three clubs on a week (one particularly aimed at involving reluctant participants), teaching dance, gymnastics, athletics and ball games in KS1 and KS2 as well as running CPD with NQTs.
2. Part funding towards our outdoor heated swimming pool.
3. Support with transport of our children to competitions.
4. Support with our Forest School provision.

Impact on last year's funding:

1. Children were offered a wide range of clubs and activities that were more suited to mixed age groups of small numbers. This included clubs such as archery and fencing and games such as 'Capture the Flag' which could be played with a mixture of younger and older children. The lunch time club is particularly successful with most children joining in with the activities at some point during lunch.
2. The outdoor pool was open throughout the Summer term and again during the first half of the Autumn Term. Children used it daily. The swimming was an excellent cardio vascular activity for all children. 4 out of the 6 Foundation children were able to swim a width by the end of the session, without floatation devices. All Year 1 and 2 children could also swim with confidence.
3. Transport enabled Holbeton to take part in all festivals and activities.
4. All children in school take part in Forest School from Foundation to Year 6 on a regular basis. Our local forest involves them having to walk a good distance and then take part in many challenges, mental as well as physical. Instilling a love of being outdoors is a vital part of the Holbeton Primary School experience.
