Hi fellow reader 🖐️

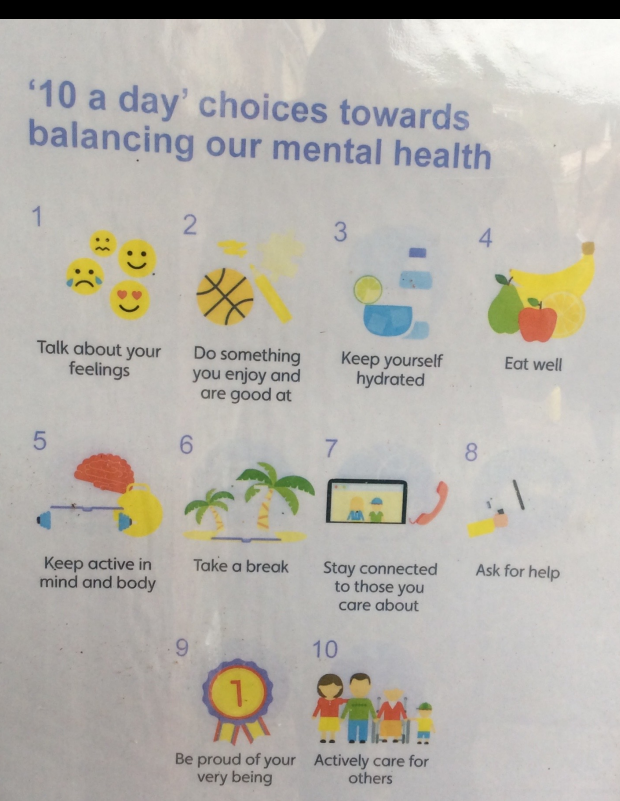

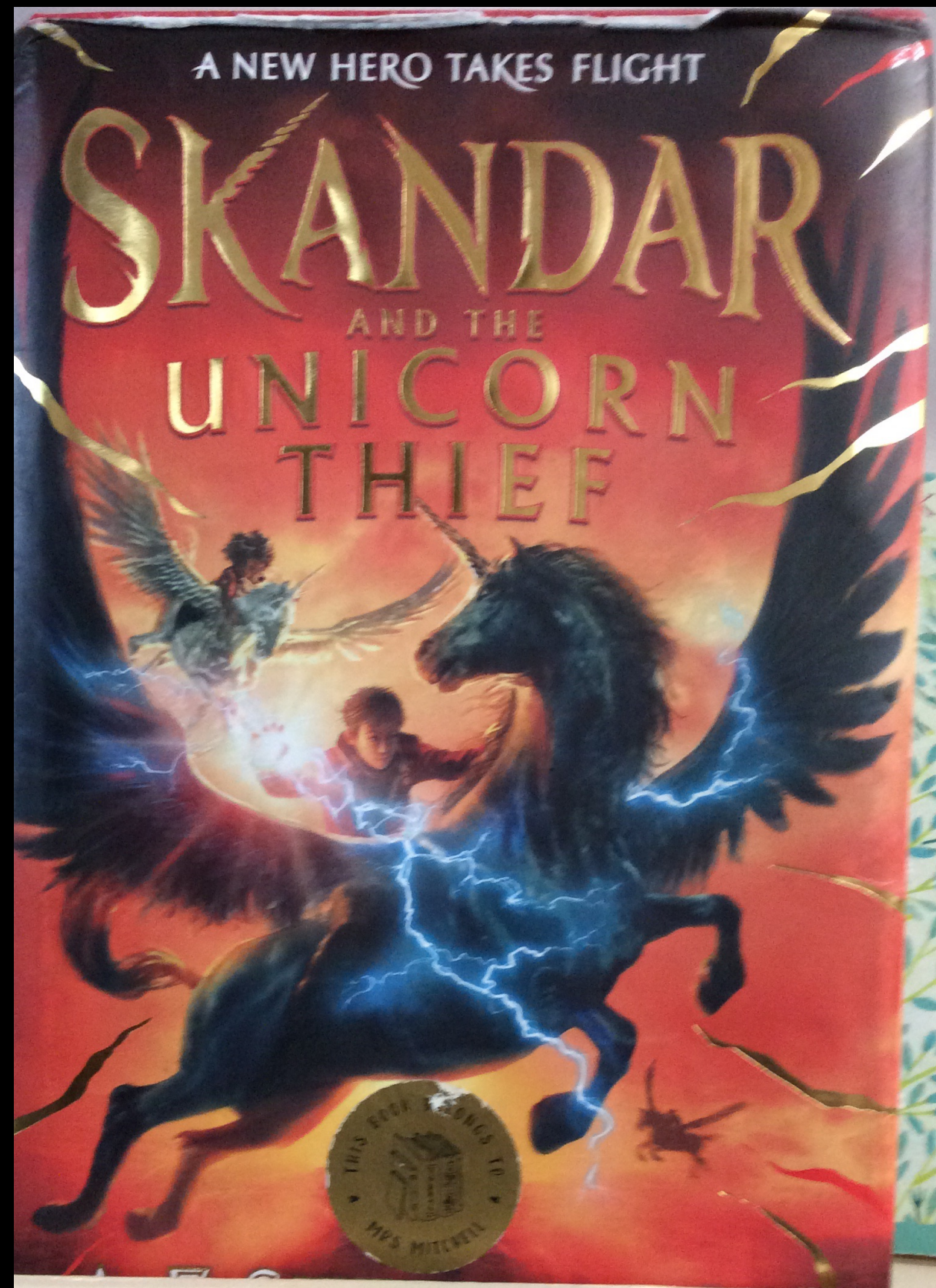
