<b>PSHE</b> In our PSHE lessons this half term, we will be thinking about valuing differences and what makes us, and other people special. We will learn important words such as: tolerance, diversity and respect and we will link these to the fundamental British Values. We will enjoy reading stories that explore these themes and creating artwork to show our understanding.	<b>History</b> In History this half term we will be learning about schools. We will be making comparisons and enquiring about similarities and differences between our school now and what it would have been like 40 years ago and even 100 years ago.

We will also be thinking about animals and how we classify them with a focus on carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
