ENGLISH

We will continue to maintain high expectations for handwriting and presentation using Letter Join and RWInc. We will be embarking on our first Book Write using the text "No Bot the Robot with No Bottom." We will explore the text and use it to plan and write our own stories. We will then be learning about non - fiction texts using Book Write "Weather."

MATHEMATICS

During our Maths lessons we will continue to build our fluency with number and place value. Year 1 will be exploring place value within 20 as well as addition and subtraction. Year 2 will be learning about money and the operations multiplication and division.

PSHE

In our PSHE lessons this half term, we will be completing the Jigsaw puzzle piece 'Dreams and Goals'. We will reflect on:

How to achieve our goals

Working collaboratively with others to achieve our goals

Reflecting on our teamwork

Geography

In Geography this half term our topic will be "We are United." We will be learning about the countries of the United Kingdom, exploring physical features, human features and understanding geographical similarities and differences between the two.

COMPUTING

In our computing lessons this half term, we will continue to learn how to use computers more purposefully, log in and navigate around a computer, drag, drop, click and control a cursor using a mouse as well as learning the importance of keeping safe online.

Art

During this half term we will be exploring line, shape, texture and collagraphy through the subject of weather.

Music

We will be learning about rhythm and rhyme using our music scheme Charanga. The unit is called: Rhythm In The Way We Walk and Banana Rap. We will aso be learning how to play the Bamboo Tamboo. We will play these instruments by hitting a Bamboo (plastic) tube on the ground then striking it with a beater to create different pitches and rhythms and perform them in groups or as a whole class.

Science

In Science we will be learning about the relationship between the Earth and the Sun - day and night and the seasons. We will then be learning about plants and trees.

PE

This half term we will have our PE session with (Arena) on a Friday. You will need to come to school wearing your PE kit on this day. Clothing needs to be suitable for different weather.

Hair must be tied up and jewellery removed for PE.

RE

Our RE units will be based around 2 key questions from the Plymouth Agreed Syllabus this half term.
