English Year 2/3

Our sequences this term are: 'A River' and "Ask Dr K Fisher about his animals'
We will be looking at how to effectively add detail to our writing through different devices. As well as developing our writing stamina further
A focus will be accuracy of composing sentences to make sure we include capital letters, full stops (Y2), commas, apostrophes (Y3)

Maths Year 2

The children will be learning about **money**, including recognising coins and notes and solving simple problems. They will explore **length and height**, as well as **mass, capacity, and temperature**, using standard units to measure and compare. Pupils will also develop their understanding of **multiplication and division** through practical activities and problem-solving.

Science Year 2/3

This term in Science, children will be learning about **choosing suitable materials** for different purposes, considering their properties such as strength, flexibility, and durability. They will develop their **working scientifically skills** by **observing materials carefully, carrying out comparative tests, and recording their findings**. These investigations will help them apply their knowledge to a practical project: **designing and planning their own dungarees**.

Maths Year 3

The children will be focusing on **multiplication**, using times tables and applying them to solve problems. They will also learn about **fractions**, including recognising and understanding equal parts. In measurement, pupils will explore **mass and capacity** and develop their skills in measuring **length and perimeter** through practical activities and problem-solving tasks.

Science Year 2/3

This term in Science, children will be learning about **choosing suitable materials** for different purposes, considering their properties such as strength, flexibility, and durability. They will develop their **working scientifically skills** by **observing materials carefully, carrying out comparative tests, and recording their findings**. These investigations will help them apply their knowledge to a practical project: **designing and planning their own dungarees**.

RE Year 3/4

This term in RE, children will be learning about **living Hindu traditions**. They will explore how Hindu beliefs are expressed in everyday life, including **rituals, festivals, and family practices**, and consider the importance of these traditions to Hindu communities today.

History Year 3/4

This term in History, children will be learning about The Indus Valley Civilization. They will explore how people lived, what they built, and the daily life, trade, and culture of this ancient society, developing their understanding of early civilizations.

Geography Year 3/4

This term in Geography, children will be learning about **settlements**. They will explore the different **types of settlements**, such as villages, towns, and cities, and understand **why people choose to live in certain places** and how settlements are organised.
